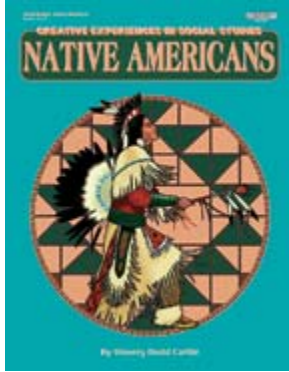


A Creative Look at Famous Explorers
